How to arrive at TU Dublin (Formerly DIT)

By Taxi (either from airport or from your hotel): Use the MyTaxi App for convenience

Dublin City ios divided in two by the River Liffey, North Side of the Liffey and South Side of the Liffey. The DIT Aungier St Campus is located on the South Side whilst the majority of buses from the airport leave you at the South Side. Dublin is walkable but there is a tram system (Luas) which you can use to travel across the city.
